**Integration course**

Information for immigrants, their families and friends

## What's an integration course ?

In the integration course immigrants can learn the German language (understanding, speaking and listening) and they get important information about the German legal system, culture and German history.

## Who can go to an integration course?

- immigrants
- relatives of soldiers at the Nato base
- people from Russia with a German passport

You can find out if you are entitled or obliged to attend a course at the Federal Office of Migration and Refugees.

## What does an integration course entail?

- The integration course is a combination of language classes and orientation class. The language classes take 600 hours and the orientation class 45 hours. The 600 hours language classes are subdivided into 6 units of 100 hours.
- Daily courses are from Monday to Friday 5 hours a day in the morning.
- At the end of the integration course a final examination will be held. This examination is at the international language level B1. You will receive a certificate for passing the test.

## Special courses for mothers

We offer integration courses for mothers with children on either 4 afternoons or 3 mornings per week. Both courses include crèche services.

## The costs of an integration course?

- For each module you have to pay 100 € in addition the workbook costs about ca. 13 €.
- If you receive Hartz IV the federal office for immigrants will cover the costs of the course.
